**Prof. Michael Taroudakis** is Professor at the Department of Mathematics and Applied Mathematics of the University of Crete. His research interests are focused on mathematical modelling of wave phenomena and in particular on applications of underwater acoustics, acoustical oceanography and seismicity. He has coordinated a large number of research projects related to underwater acoustics and has participated in many more as principal researcher. He has taught a great number of undergraduate and graduate courses at the National Technical University of Athens, the University of Crete, the Hellenic Mediterranean University and the University of the Aegean in Greece.

He has been President of the International Commission for Acoustics (2016-2019), President of the European Acoustics Association (2013-2016) and President of the Hellenic Institute of Acoustics (2008-2014). Recently he has co-coordinated the International Year of Sound 2020-2021. He has been Rector of the University of Crete, Dean of the School of Sciences and Engineering and Chair of the Department of Mathematics of same University.

He has organized many international and national conferences and workshops on research and educational subjects. He has published more than 100 papers or chapters in Scientific Journals, Books and Conference Proceedings and has given invited or key-note talks in many conferences.
